



Required Documents for Higher Studies & Work Abroad

This document outlines the required documents for students and professionals planning to study or work abroad. Requirements vary between countries, universities, and employers—always verify with the official authorities.

Academic Documents

- 10th Marks Memo / Certificate
- 12th Marks Memo / Certificate
- UG/PG Degree Certificates
- All Academic Transcripts
- Medium of Instruction (MOI) certificate if documents are not in English

Identity & Personal Documents

- Passport (all pages)
- Passport-size photographs
- National ID (if required)

English Proficiency

- IELTS / TOEFL / PTE scorecards
- Some universities may accept MOI instead of IELTS — verify individually

Supporting Documents for Education

- Statement of Purpose (SOP)
- Letters of Recommendation (LORs)
- Resume / Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- Experience Certificate (if applicable)
- Language Certificate (if any)

Work-Related Documents

- Updated Resume
- Experience Certificates
- Salary Slips (last 3–6 months)
- Offer/Employment Letters
- Relieving Letters (if applicable)
- Professional Licenses

Financial & Legal Documents

- Bank Statements (3–6 months)
- Affidavit of Support
- Income Tax Returns (ITR)
- Loan Sanction Letter
- Police Clearance Certificate (PCC)
- Social Insurance Certificate (if applicable)

Health & Travel Documents

- Medical Certificate
- Vaccination Records
- Flight Itinerary (if applicable)

Country-wise Notes & IELTS / MOI Requirements

United Kingdom (UK)

- IELTS Academic commonly required.
- Some universities accept MOI or pre-sessional English.
- TB Test may be required based on country.

United States (USA)

- Universities decide English requirements—TOEFL/IELTS usually needed.
- Many universities accept MOI based on previous education.
- Visa requires SEVIS Fee & I-20 form.

Canada

- IELTS/TOEFL/CELPIP depending on institution.
- GIC required for some programs.
- Some institutions accept MOI for admission.

Australia

- IELTS/TOEFL/PTE usually required.
- GTE requirement mandatory.

New Zealand

- IELTS typically required for most programs.
- Check university-specific requirements.

Germany

- English programs accept IELTS/TOEFL; some accept MOI.
- German-taught programs require German proficiency certificates.

Ireland

- IELTS/TOEFL mandatory for most programs.

Europe (Schengen)

- Requirements vary by country.
- Universities may require English/French/German language proof.

Important: Requirements vary and may change. Always verify with the university/employer and the official immigration website.
